## FAMILY MEDIATION and PARENTING COUNSELING for RETURNING CITIZENS

Family Reunification helps to rebuild family ties harmed by incarceration. We offer FREE counseling to help with:

- Parenting when *one or both parents* are in reentry after coming home from incarceration
- Building *communication skills* for a *stable home life* while navigating reentry
- Talking through *family disputes* or *reconnecting* with chosen or birth family after reentry

The trauma of jail or prison can have an impact on life and family relationships even after returning home. You can work through it with your chosen or birth family\* and a trained mediator in a safe and convenient virtual setting.

\*all participants must be 18+ years of age

***Reentry is just the first step. Reunification is the ultimate goal!***
